

1. Title of the grant project: **Towards a cognitively plausible compositional model for natural language quantification;**
2. Principal Investigator: Justyna Grudzińska-Zawadowska;
3. Funding: Narodowe Centrum Nauki;
4. Type of the grant project: OPUS-18;
5. Host institution: University of Warsaw, Faculty of Philosophy;
6. Number of positions: 1;
7. The position is open to researchers who hold at least a PhD degree (known as the Candidate of Sciences under the Ukrainian system) and who worked at Ukrainian universities and other research centres before the war, and as a result of the war arrived in Poland on February 24, 2022 or later.
8. Requirements and qualifications:
 - good background in deep learning, machine learning, natural language processing;
 - good coding skills, especially in Python;
 - research interest in the grant topic (<https://sites.google.com/view/justyna-grudzinska/project-commonlang?authuser=0>)
9. Form and duration of employment: contract work ("umowa o dzieło"), for 10 months;
10. Remuneration: PLN 2400 gross per month;
11. The application should include:
 - current curriculum vitae, including a description of prior research, education, professional information (previous employment), language proficiency, grants/honours, a list of publications and conference presentations.
